Personal data we process:

European Motor Company processes your personal data because you use our services and/or because you provide it to us yourself.

Below is an overview of the personal data we process:

- First and last name
- Address data
- Telephone number
- E-mail address
- Chamber of Commerce number (if applicable) - VAT number (if applicable)
- Bank account number

Special and/or sensitive personal data we process:

Our website and/or service does not intend to collect data on website visitors who are under 16 years of age. Unless they have permission from parents or guardian. However, we cannot verify whether a visitor is older than 16. We therefore advise parents to be involved in their children's online activities to avoid collecting data on children without parental consent. For what purpose and on what basis do we process personal data:

European Motor Company processes your personal data for the following purposes:

- Handling your payment/order
- Sending our newsletter and/or advertising folder
- Calling or e-mailing you if necessary to carry out our services
- Informing you about changes to our services and products

Automated decision-making:

European Motor Company does not make decisions about matters that could (significantly) affect individuals on the basis of automated processing. This concerns decisions that are made by computer programmes or systems, without a human being (e.g. an employee of European Motor Company) sitting between them.

How long we keep personal data:

European Motor Company will not retain your personal data for longer than is strictly necessary to fulfil the purposes for which your data is collected. We use the following retention periods for the following (categories) of personal data:

Sharing personal data with third parties:

European Motor Company only provides third parties and only when necessary for the performance of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation.

Shipping and logistics:

If you place an order with us, our job is to get your package delivered to you. We use the services of various carriers to carry out deliveries. This requires us to share your name, address, place of residence, email and phone number with them.

Cookies, or similar techniques, that we use:

European Motor Company uses cookies in its website. A cookie is a simple small file of data created by a website and stored by your browser on your computer's hard drive. We use cookies to facilitate the use of our web shop/ make logging in to our website easier/ remember your settings and preferences. You can disable these cookies via your browser, but this will negatively affect the functioning of our website. With your permission, we place 'tracking cookies' on your computer. We use these cookies to track which pages you visit in order to build up a profile of your online behaviour. This profile is not linked to your name, address, e-mail address and the like, but only to tailor advertisements to your profile so that they are as relevant to you as possible. You can only delete cookies yourself, as they are stored on your computer. Please refer to your browser manual for this.

View, modify or delete data:

You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. In addition, you have the right to withdraw your possible consent to data processing or object to the processing of your personal data by European Motor Company and you have the right to data portability. This means you can submit a request to us to send the personal data we hold on you in a computer file to you or another organisation named by you.

You can send a request for inspection, correction, deletion, data transfer of your personal data or a request to withdraw your consent or object to the processing of your personal data to info@european-motorcompany.com.

To ensure that the request for inspection is made by you, we ask you to send a copy of your proof of identity with the request. In this copy, black out your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip of numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number and Citizen Service Number (BSN). This is to protect your privacy. We will respond to your request as soon as possible, but within four weeks.

European Motor Company would also like to inform you that you have the opportunity to submit a complaint to the national supervisory authority, the Personal Data Authority.
